



Become a *Parent Leader at PS 9!*

The “Parent Leaders at PS 9” program equips PS 9 volunteers with the knowledge and skills to provide school-based support. This is the only program at PS 9 that will allow you to work directly with students and teachers to support learning at PS 9.

Trained parents and grandparents help staff the library, work in the Reading Resource Room to organize and label books, assist the school’s art and music teachers, and so much more!

To participate in this program, volunteers must be current PS 9 parents and grandparents and must complete a mandatory, one-time training (held only at the start of the school year). All volunteers commit to a code of conduct and strive to serve as positive role models for all students. Once certified, volunteers are eligible to participate as a “Parent Leader” for as long their children remain enrolled at PS 9.

The dates for this year’s training sessions for new volunteers are:

Tuesday, September 26
Wednesday, October 11
Friday, October 13

While several sessions were scheduled to allow more parents to attend, you need to attend only one training session.

All trainings will be held from **8:45 am to 10:20 am** in the cafeteria. Walk-ins welcome.
