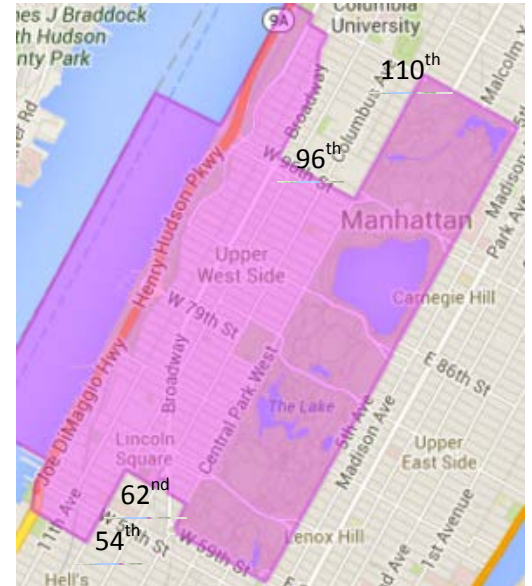
For PS9 and the Center School to get funding to replace the auditorium seats
